The Opportunity:

This is a local temporary position working at our client site **Syncrude** in **Fort McMurray, AB**. The Cat Vacuum Truck Operator is responsible for operating the Cat Vacuum units in a safe, responsible, and efficient manner.

- Responsibly transport, load, and offload fluid, at different locations throughout the mine

- Perform thorough equipment inspections.
- Safely operate equipment on mining roads in wet, dry, dusty, and frozen conditions
- Must be capable of working independently and demonstrate a professional demeanor.
- Perform other duties as assigned by supervision and as required by operational demands.
