Accountabilities:

- Driving, hauling, and dispensing gasoline, fuel oil, lubricating oil, or liquefied petroleum gas to clients

- Clean and lubricate equipment and refill equipment tanks.
- Oversee condition of equipment and conduct pre/post-checks on equipment.

- Reads gauges or meters and record quantity loaded.
- Plan travel schedules and routes.
- Drive lighter, special purpose trucks if required.

- Complete all maintenance tasks to ensure equipment, housekeeping, and work areas are kept to best standards and safe working conditions.

- Maintain safety and maintenance records in compliance with procedure.
- Operate vehicles and equipment as required to complete various tasks.
