- Keep pathways, sidewalks, and parking lots clean of snow and ice.
- Perform daily pre-trips of equipment to ensure equipment remains in working operational condition and does not pose a safety hazard to other employees, clients, or the public.
- Accurately complete safety paperwork and follow all safe work procedures.
- Monitor and report on equipment maintenance requirements.

Requirements and Competencies:

- Class 5 driver's license required.
- Pre-employment drug & alcohol testing is required.
- Ability to operate skid-steers, loaders, or graders, considered a strong asset.
- Snow removal experience is considered an asset.
- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds.
- Must be flexible and work effectively in a fast-paced environment.
- Must communicate effectively and understand written and verbal instructions.
- Must be dependable and reliable.
- Strong interpersonal skills.
- Must be physically able to perform all duties.

Schedule:

- 14 days of 10-hour shifts, followed by 7 days off. Camp accommodations are provided.
