The Role:

Under general supervision, perform production welding, service and repair welding, prototype building, fabrication, and fitter welding.

Accountabilities

- Perform assigned duties in a safe and efficient manner and abide by all company policies and procedures.
- The use of various hand tools, machinery and equipment will be required to manufacture metal products.
- This position will work with Managers, Supervisors and Lead Hands to make improvements to a variety of equipment.
- Welder will be required to assist the various divisions with insight and knowledge of superior manufacturing methods, perform random maintenance, and have strong knowledge and skill in operating all metalworking machinery.
- Required to be able to read and understand production drawings, blueprints, work orders and other written instructions.
- Conduct Technical Inspections.
- Conduct repairs, modifications, and retrofits.
- Identify and correct any problems found in machines, equipment, or processes in order to facilitate operation.
- Provide on the job training to other employees and new hires when requested.
- Ensure proper logs are maintained of condition and location of equipment for proper shift hand-over. Ability to foster a cooperative work environment.
- Required to operate trucks in a safe manner in congested and confined areas.
- Keeps tools, equipment, and work area clean, organized, and in good working condition.

- Interprovincial Red Seal or CWB tickets.
- Valid welding certification.

- Possess a valid Class 5 driver's license with a clean abstract
- Ability to work independently or in a busy environment.
- Experience with routine maintenance operations.
